Light Green- (the lightest green shade) is the color of a yellow based budgie with no dark factors. Dark Green- (the medium green shade), is the color of a yellow based budgie with 1 dark factor. Olive- (the darkest green shade) is the color of a yellow based budgie with 2 dark factors.

The original budgie variety is yellow-based with blue feather structure in the body feathers, resulting in the classic green coloration of the main body (yellow+blue=green). Observe the striping pattern on the head and wings, which are both the normal type. All varieties other than the original wild-type have occurred in budgies bred in captivity.

We have seen that the wild type budgie has green body colour and a yellow face. These colours are caused by melanin and psittacin - two types of pigment. Melanin is responsible for the brown, blacks, greys and other dark colours that you see on a budgie, including blue. Psittacin gives the yellow pigment. This means that a green budgie is actually a bird with blue body colour but with yellow over it.

Usually, the cere of a male budgie will be blue in color whereas it

It often has a brilliant iridescent feel about it, like the budgie on the right below. Their cheek patches are bright violet and the tail is a dark blue.

Greens come in three different colours, you get Light Green, Dark Green and Olive Green. In each colour variation there is a

darker shade than the previous one. Purely in the colour, you will have the genes which can breed as well as Greens but also can breed Blues.

Budgie Breeding Age. Budgies are physically able to breed after six months, but should not be allowed to do so until they are at least 10 months old. A younger bird will often fail to be a good parent. There's no hurry - once they've matured, females will be able to breed for four years, and males for six.

The many color variations of budgerigars, such as albino, blue, cinnamon, Clearwinged, the various Fallows, Grey, Greygreen, Greywing, Lutino, Mauve, Olive, Opaline, Spangled, Suffused and Violet are the result of mutations that have occurred within specific genes. There are actually at least thirty-two known primary mutations established among budgerigars.

Look at the cheek patches, body color, and main tail feathers for the best indications of which mutation your budgie is. Normal olives will have deep violet cheek patches. The grey green color adding factor effects the cheek patches causing them to be blue/grey rather than violet.
