The risk for ADL decline in long-term care residents is a serious issue that often leads to falls, pressure ulcers, weight loss, depression, and other negative outcomes. To ensure quality outcomes and to comply with federal regulation, nursing facilities must have a comprehensive and effective restorative program that encourages each resident's highest level of function.

### Guide to Successful Restorative Programs

Restorative nursing programs are targeted nursing programs that promote independence and safety for the resident. In alignment with regulatory requirements, an effective restorative program focuses on physical, mental, and psychosocial functioning while ensuring the resident is at the center of all care.

### Utilizing Restorative Nursing Programs to Optimize ...

Restorative Nursing Program (RNP) refers to nursing interventions that promote the resident's ability to adapt and adjust to living as independently and safely as possible. This concept actively focuses on achieving and maintaining optimal physical, mental, and psychosocial functioning.

### Restore Your Restorative Nursing Program

Restorative programs are not required by federal regulation, but what is required is that facilities provide services to help residents maintain or attain their highest practicable level of physical, mental, and psychosocial well-being. Meeting this goal necessitates restorative programming. However, successfully implementing restorative programming has its own challenges.

### Barriers to Implementing a Successful Restorative Program ...

### restorative nursing in long term care - Geriatric / LTC ...

Our plan called for all LTC residents to have an appropriate five-day restorative nursing program each week. Rehab staff evaluated all LTC residents with two goals in mind. First, the therapist would determine if the

resident experienced a decline in function and, if so, a treatment plan would be developed.

### **Restorative nursing: It takes a facility - I Advance ...**

Despite the benefits of physical activity, residents living in long-term care (LTC) are relatively sedentary. Designing successful physical activity and restorative care programs requires a good understanding of implementation barriers. A database search (2002–2013) yielded seven studies (nine articles) that met our inclusion criteria.

Restorative nursing programs are a vital component of the care provided in a nursing home because they contribute to improved and prolonged quality of life for your residents. Assembling the appropriate staff and providing the extensive training needed are integral to the success of your restorative nursing program.

### **How to Set Up a Restorative Care Program for a Nursing ...**

Many nursing homes have restorative nursing programs designed to ensure each resident will maintain the functional gains made in physical, occupational and speech therapy. Restorative nursing services can help ensure that each resident will maintain his or her maximum functional capacity as outlined in the care plan.

Providing evidence that restorative care is effective for long stay residents may help nursing homes select participants. All nursing homes receiving reimbursement from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services are required to report the results of standardized assessments of resident health using the Minimum Data Set (MDS).
