Writing exercises for ESL Learners

One common type of run-on sentence is a comma splice. A comma splice occurs when two independent clauses are joined with just a comma.. Example of a comma splice: Participants could leave the study at any time, they needed to indicate their preference. Sentence 1: Participants could leave the study at any time. Sentence 2: They needed to indicate their preference.

Run-On Sentences and Sentence Fragments - Grammar ...

A sentence fragment is an incomplete thought or clause. As opposed to a complete thought that is exhibited by complete sentences. Fragments usually are parts of sentences that are somehow disconnected from the main clause. This usually escapes use because many times an incomplete thought can imitate complete sentence.
